## **SHARED OWNERSHIP**

#### What is shared ownership?

If you would like to own your own home but cannot afford to buy on the open market, then shared ownership could be for you. You will have sole occupancy rights, which means you do not have to share your home with anyone else.

Shared ownership allows you to buy a share of a house or flat (usually from a housing association), and pay rent for the remainder. Your monthly outgoings will include repayments on any mortgage you have taken out, plus a subsidised rent on the part of the property retained by the housing association. Further shares in the property may be purchased at a later stage offering shared-owners the opportunity to eventually own their own home outright.

We have recently sent out information on four properties available in Hackney at this time, there will be another property becoming available this year. We will also have five properties becoming available in Newham towards the end 2003 or the beginning 2004.

# ANNUAL GAS SAFETY CHECKS

#### **GOVERNMENT GRANTS**

# For private householders and private tenants

The government has provided funds for a grant of up to £2,500 for each qualifying households in this area, to carry out work to make your home more comfortable and more energy efficient.

#### FREE OF CHARGE!

(Providing the cost of the work falls within the grant maximum)

Do you qualify?

If you are over 60 you can claim up to £2,500

Do you receive any of these?

Income Support, Housing Benefit, Council Tax Benefit, Attendance Allowance

Families with young children. You can claim up to £1,500

If you receive any of the above, or: Working Families' Tax Credit, Income-Based Job Seeker's Allowance, or if you are pregnant a MAT B1 Certificate.

#### Disabled? You may be able to claim up to £1,500

If you receive any of the above or:

Disabled Person's Tax Credit, Disability Living Allowance, Industrial Injuries Disablement Pension, War Disablement Pension (which must include the mobility supplement or constant attendance allowance), Industrial Injuries Disablement Benefit (which must include constant attendance allowance).

THEN YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR FREE DRAUGHTPROOFING OR CAVITY WALL INSULATION OR LOFT INSULATION.
YOU MAY ALSO QUALIFY FOR FREE REPAIRS TOO, OR INSTALLATION OF CENTRAL HEATING.

Apply if you (or your partner) are employed or selfemployed, work at least 16 hours on low earnings and

Are 16 or over and responsible for at least one child, or

Aged 16 or over and disabled, or

Aged 25 or over and work 30 hours or more

It could be worth up to £69.70 per week

#### CHILD TAX CREDIT

If you are responsible for at least one child or young person apply now.

It could be worth up to £38 per week for the first child.

You get more if you have more than one child.

You get more if you have a baby under 1 years old.

If you don't apply, you won't get it

If you get Housing /Council Tax Benefit you must tell us of any award

#### DUMPING RUBBISH

Can all tenants please ensure that household rubbish is disposed of properly in black bin bags and any cardboard boxes are taken apart, minimising the size and then put into black bags.

Please make proper use of your bins and help in keeping your area clean and tidy.

Remember, that rubbish not only gives the area you live in a bad appearance; it also attracts the infestation of mice, insects etc and is very unhygienic.

Note: it is a breach of your tenancy agreement to dump unwanted items of rubbish. If this continues the association will have no choice but to increase the service charges in October 2003 and this will not be eligible for Housing


